CME EMT-Refresher Core Content Course – Fall 2009

Again this fall, Saratoga County EMS will conduct a complete Pilot/CME EMT Refresher Core Content course. This 14 session program includes 24 hours of core content required for EMT-B and EMT-I Pilot Refresher participants PLUS required verification of EMT-Basic practical skills. An additional 4 sessions cover mandatory WMD (6 hours) and Geriatrics (3 hours), plus elective Bariatrics (3 hours). The total 42 hours of NYS approved pilot refresher training can be used to meet pilot refresher program requirements. The program will run Tuesday evenings:

All sessions will be held in the comfort of the Saratoga County Fire Training Center (see directions on the back of this page), away from the noise and disturbances often experienced at home department training, and not just supervised but actually taught by seasoned NYS Certified Instructor Coordinators (CICs). The entire program has been preapproved by NYS and participants will receive completion verification for each session they attend.

Tuition for the entire 14-session program is \$250 payable the first night of class (pilot EMT-B agencies are eligible for \$300 NYS reimbursement following completion of the refresher program) or \$25 each for classroom sessions and \$90 for Practical Skills verification (2 sessions).

Directions to the Saratoga County Fire Training Center

FROM ALBANY:

- Take 1-87 to Exit 12
- Left off exit, proceed West on Route 67 for about 3 miles
- At the junction of Route 50 (traffic light) turn right (onto Rte 50)
- Turn left at the next traffic light onto Route 67, also known as West High Street. (You will be heading West).
- Follow Route 67 to the next traffic light and turn right onto Middleline Rd.
- Take first right off Middleline Rd. onto County Farm Rd.
- Follow to an intersection and turn left into County Farm.
- Pass Sheriff's Office/Jail and animal shelter. The Byron J. Baker Fire Training Center is the next building on the left.

FROM GLENS FALLS:

- Take 1-87 to Exit 13S
- At traffic light turn right onto Malta Avenue.
- Follow for about 1 mile. Turn right onto *Northline Rd. (this will be your second right after going over the Northway).
- Take Northline until you see a sign for the Saratoga County Department of Public works - turn left there. (Sign will be shortly after you go over the Kaydeross Creek).
- Go past the gas pumps and turn left.
- Proceed past Sheriff's Department and turn left.
- The Training Center is the second building on your left.

*Please note at some point in your journey Northline Rd will change to Galway Rd.
